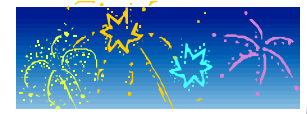

*The Water Year is used by hydrologists to show the monthly patterns of precipitation (both rain and snow), evaporation/evapotranspiration from vegetation, runoff, and groundwater recharge, the primary components of the hydrologic cycle. Hydrologists use a year that begins on October 1st when soil moisture begins to be recharged following the summer months of high evaporation and transpiration that exceed the precipitation.
